Scholarship Rules:

1. In 2023, 2 Scholarships of \$500.00 each will be awarded. The full amount to be given at the beginning of the first semester.
2. The funds for the scholarships are raised by members of the MWAL.
3. The Scholarship Applicant or one of his/her parents or grandparents must be a member of the MWAL.
4. The Scholarship Applicant must have graduated from high school or received a GED by the first semester of enrollment in an accredited, post-secondary school.
5. The Scholarship Applicant must attend an accredited, post-secondary school and must be taking at least six credits or an accredited licensing program. Proof of enrollment may be requested prior to the awarding of scholarship.
6. Only one application per student will be allowed.
7. The application is due May 1, 2023.
8. A Scholarship Committee will select the award winners.
9. The Scholarship Committee shall consist of members of the MWAL Executive Board.
10. The Scholarship Committee will conduct a random drawing of the qualified applicants at the executive board meeting held in May, 2023. The Committee will draw and list all names in order drawn, the first and second names drawn will be the Scholarship Winners. If either winner becomes ineligible, the scholarships will be awarded to the next person that had been drawn.

The winners will be notified after the completion of the drawing and must then provide information for the scholarship money to be sent directly to their colleges or Universities. Winners' names will be printed in the May, 2023 Flash Report.
